### Luggage

- •One medium size suitcase or duffel bag (to be checked through to Beijing)
- •One carry-on (backpack for daily trips)

## TO BRING:

## Clothing (Less is More.)

- •All clothing should be in GOOD CONDITION!

  No holes, tears, patches....
- •Classroom dress is required. Boys' shirts should be collared. "Modesty" is the rule for Girls.

#### Miscellaneous

- -Journal (to be distributed in Boston)
- -Digital Camera, extra memory cards. Extra batteries!

(Not a Phone or iPad)

-Host gift—Please talk to one of the chaperones if you are having trouble finding a gift!

# **Optional**

- -Something to read on the plane or at night.
- -Watch
- -Comfort food—granola bars, crackers, trail mix...

### No Computers or cell phones!

### Suggested clothing:

- -3 pairs of pants (dark in color is best) (leggings are not pants)
- -5 shirts (At least one button down shirt for boys and one nice shirt for girls)
- -1 light-weight fleece/sweater/GOULD sweatshirt (No hoodies!)
- -1 heavier fleece for layering while in Beijing.
- -1 waterproof/windbreaker jacket.
- -Undergarments and socks for 10 days
- -Pajamas
- -One pair of comfortable shoes (you will be walking everywhere in China!)

### Toiletries:

- -Toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, brush, a few small packets of tissues etc.
- -A small bottle of hand sanitizer

### **Carry-on Bag Restrictions**

- No sharp objects
- •No lighters or matches.

(You shouldn't have them anyway!)

- No aerosol cans
- •Small amounts (3 oz.) of liquid/gel-based products may be carried in a plastic bag

(One quart zip lock!).

\*\*\*\*Remember that you will need to carry all your luggage whenever we are traveling. Pack as lightly as possible, you will want space to bring things home (like a present for your mother)!\*\*\*\*
